What will I learn?

This Course extends the skills learned and practiced at the Basic Tube Feeding stage to look at the feeding of more difficult birds, including parrots.

Who is the course suited to?

Pre-requisites

- Completed Basic Tube Feeding competencies.
- Been a Basic Tube Feeder on shift for at least 3 months.
- Have an approved Mentor.

After attending the course, to complete the relevant BTF competencies you will need to be guided and progressively signed off by your Mentor, usually within 3-6 months after the course date (depending on scope for practice etc.).

How do I sign up?

- Put the completed Form in the Hospital Manager's in-tray.
