What will I learn?

Introduces, describes and demonstrates the procedures used to tube feed doves and pigeons only.

Provides general information on nutrition for different bird species, and the importance of problem awareness.

While some patient assessment skill is required at the Basic Tube Feeding (BTF) level, the focus of the course is on the skills required in handling the tube and bird, and preparing and administering the feed.



Who is the course suited to?

- Pre-requisites** :
- Completed New Volunteer Competencies
 - Completed Bird Handling

After attending the course, to complete the relevant BTF competencies you will need to be guided and progressively signed off by your Mentor, usually within 3-6 months after the course date (depending on scope for practice etc.).

Your Mentor should therefore be someone who has themselves completed the BTF competencies and can actively oversee your practice and progression on your own shift.

How do I sign up?
